October 2015 report: Crews were dispatched to remove leaves from the tops of catch basins on 10/29/15.

The shoulders were cut on Atchison Rd., Hoodlum Hill Rd. and Treadwell Rd.
The ditches were cleaned on Dorman Rd. The Gradall’s transmission malfunctioned and it has yet to be determined the course of corrective action. Ditching has effectively ended for the season.

Broome Bituminous paved Fox Rd. off of Brooks Rd. and the lower portion of Brotzman Rd. from Rt. 12 up to the intersection of Edelweiss.

Sluice pipes were replaced at Hoodlum Hill Rd., and at field on Treadwell Rd.

The following roads had areas that were strip patched: Brotzman Rd., Buckley Rd., Dimmock Hill Rd., Duryea Rd., Edelweiss, John Smith Rd., Port Rd., Sky View Lane, Treadwell, Willis and Wilson Hill Rds.

Yard waste, chipping and roadside mowing continued throughout the month of October.

November 2015 report: The creek running under Parsons Rd. was cleaned out.

The shoulders were cut on Atchison Rd.

The backhoe cleaned ditches out on Wilson Hill Road.

The last of the hot patching was done on Bishop Rd., Sky View Lane, Jacobs Highway and Mix Rd.

Trees were taken down on Willis Road.

A low spot on Mix Road was repaired with millings.
