### Attn Town Board:

The Public Works Dept is asking the Town board to allow the use of ARPA funds to purchase standby generators for the remaining water pumping stations that do not have them, and reimbursement to the Water department for the purchase and installation of a standby generator for Pennview Water station. We would also like to purchase a second standby generator that is portable, and use it for the Sewer Pumping stations. (See attached generator pricing)

### Why we need these:

In April the Town received a late season heavy snow storm dropped over 14" of snow in some parts of the Town. This left the Town of Chenango's Water pumping stations that did not have standby generator without power, 19 sewer pumping stations were also powerless. The Town has 2 tow behind generator for the departments to use. The smaller generator is only able to supply power to our smaller single-phase stations from the 81 overpass by tractor supply south to Nirchi's (Osheas, Presscott rd, Daysinn pumping stations) and Pennview water station. The second larger generator does all our 3 phase lift stations, and we found out during the storm Chenango heights and Maplewood well house.

No one anticipated that our stations would be without power for 2-3 days. We have gone 24hrs in the past but never to this extent. After we realized that the power was not going to be restored in a reasonable amount of time, I had to utilize the generators as I seen fit. I had to stop pumping the sewer stations down and have the electricians wire up our small single-phase generator to Pennview water station so we didn't go below acceptable pressures. I also sent the larger generator to Run Acres water pumping station to run over night to maintain the pressures. While this was going on the sewer pumping stations were filling fast.

In day 2 we were utilizing both generators to maintain adequate pressure at Pennview and Run acres water stations, but also pumping down what we could in the sewer stations in between changing locations. I had to make a judgement call as to what was more important at that given time. Late in day 2 I felt that our Maplewood tank was getting drastically low. We have a storage capacity of 1.90 days per the size of tank and amount of consumption used per day. I had to stop pumping water and sewer at other places and have the electrician wire up a temporary breaker to allow us to power Applewood water pumping station to try to get water in our tank. At that point for the sewer stations I was utilizing the towns Portable pumping station and hired septic hauler to pump out other stations that were at capacity.

After several hours of pumping water into the Maplewood tank I had the electrician prepare Chenango heights station to accept the generator connection to run the pump for a few hrs. to put water in the

tank. In between water stations the Public works used the generator and pumping station to pump what they could in the sewer. At this point we were getting power back to some of the sewer stations.

Long story short we got lucky that our sewers did not backup into the streets or homes, we had just enough storage in our water tanks to maintain and lastly Employees that were willing to work all hours of the night to keep up. I urge the board to allow the uses of the ARPA money to purchase the quoted generators. I have a bad feeling that with the push for electric cars, charging stations, amount of power outages that occur each yr. it is going to happen at some point where the duration of outage will exceed our capacities with our tanks or stations.

### Secondly:

I would also like to utilize some of the ARPA funds to have 8-foot chain link fencing with vehicle access gates installed at our water tanks. In our annual Risk Assessment for the Water Dept fencing/deterrents for vandalism is recommended. I would strongly recommend that the Town allows the use of the funds to be utilized. I have attached an email conversation from a local vendor with an estimated cost. I am aware multiple quotes or going out to bid will be needed, this is just a ball park figure without having vendors to the site. Once I have confirmation that the Town is interested in moving fwd. with this I will have vendors visit the location. (See attached email)

Hi Greg,

So at the top of a lot of hills, it is very rocky or even solid rock at the surface so we'd have to look at the sites. Sometimes the digging can be almost impossible.

My best guess for all of these jobs with gates, 8 ft. high with no barbed wire would be in the \$81 to \$86 thousand dollar range at NY State Prevailing Wage rates.

That is for a total of 1080 feet of fence with double drive gates at each location. Any questions let me know.

# Local Law No. 4 of the year 2022

# A LOCAL LAW AMENDING SECTION 73-9 OF THE TOWN CODE ENTITLED "ZONING"

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Chenango as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> Section 73-9G entitled "Fire and safety hazards" shall be amended as follows:
  - (1) Remains the same
  - (2) Repealed.

# Section 2. Separability

The provisions of this local law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of this local law or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this local law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and as if such person or circumstance, to which the local law or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempt therefrom.

## Section 3. Repealer

All Ordinances, Local Laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

## Section 4. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
